



Notes:

- All material 3/4 exterior plywood.
- 3/4 pine, spruce or cedar boards can also be used.
- If thickness of item 1 is increased from 3/4", reduce the lengths of items 3 and 4 to suit.
- Note location of grooves on part #5 (door)
- Nail together with 2" ardox nails
- For more durability, glue and screw together
- Use #7x2 wood screws with exterior wood glue
- For door hinge pins use 2" ardox nails
- Use sand paper to remove any rough edges on the entrance hole
- Paint outside of box with an exterior latex paint (brown or grey)
- Do not paint the interior of the box
- Parts numbered in order of assembly
- Use a #8 x 1-1/4 wood screw to lock box door
- Box must be mounted on steel pipe or T post with predator guard
- Entrance hole faces S-E (in Ontario)
- Entrance hole approximately 1.83m (6ft) from ground
